It provides a forum for children to pursue their Natural curiosity and inventiveness to quench their thirst for creativity.

The theme of the Rajya Stariya Bal Vaigyanik Pradarshani (RSBVP) 2023-24 given by NCERT is **"Science and Technology for Society"** pertaining to the areas (sub-themes):

- 1. Health
- 2. LiFE (Lifestyle for environment)
- 3. Agriculture
- 4. Communication & Transport
- 5. Computational Thinking

(Note: Sub-themes listed above are suggestive in nature. Students may develop innovative models on any other sub-theme, pertaining to the main theme-Science and Technology for Society.

The Rajya Stariya Bal Vaigyanik Pradarshani (RSBVP) 2023-24 will be organized at two levels i.e. the Preliminary Level and the Final Level in the premises of SCERT, Sector 32 C, Chandigarh. The Preliminary Level of the Exhibition will be held from 17th October to 20th October, 2023. Only two students shall be allowed to accompany one model and only one teacher shall accompany all models from one school. (In case your model is selected for the participation at National Level Science Exhibition i.e. Rashtriya Bal Vaigyanik Pradarshani (RBVP) the student registered at No. 1 will only be allowed to participate.)

- The students of all Govt. and Private Schools can participate in two categories: Elementary Category (Class VI to VIII)
 - b)
 - Secondary and Higher Secondary Category (IX to XII)

Instructions:

- Senior Secondary/High Schools can participate in both catgegories. The students of class VI to VIII will be eligible to participate at Elementary Category and the students of IX to XII will be eligible to participate at Secondary and Higher Secondary/Senior Secondary Category.
- Schools can participate in all the sub-themes. However, only one model per sub • theme per school will be allowed in each category.
- Only one table will be given for the display of one model/exhibit. Charts should be of normal size (not more than 2 charts).
- The entries for participation should be sent on the prescribed proforma and must reach this office by 20.09.2023 after which no entries will be accepted.
- The result of the Preliminary Level will be displayed on the Notice Board and Website of SCERT on 31.10.2023. No separate letters will be sent to the respective schools in this regard.
- The timings for the exhibition will be from 9:30 am to 3:30 pm every day.

The Final Level of RSBVP-2023 will be organised in the last week of November 2023 in which the selected model from Preliminary Level shall be exhibited.
