Rules and regulation for the Inter School State Tournament

Students as per following table are eligible to participate in Inter school state tournament.

Important Note:

- I) **There is no class boundation in National School Games as well as in Inter School State Tournament.** As per the guidelines of Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (MYAS) Online Linkage of Aadhar Card of each participants of National School Games at the time of online entry is made mandatory. So it is mandatory for participation in Inter School State tournament 2022-23.
 - II) A player can participate in any discipline, in the same age group for three years only However, if a player fails, he/she can participate only once thereafter in the same age group with same class/standard (i.e. player can participate two times with the same class)
 - III) In the age group of U-14 a players studying below 6th standard/class is not allowed to participate in Inter School State Tournament. In the age group of U-11 a player studying below 3rd standard/class is not allowed to participate.
 - IV) In the discipline of Table tennis, Badminton, Chess and Lawn Tennis tournament, the team should consist of minimum three players and they must be present during the tournament. The maximum no. of players are five.
 - V) In the Discipline of weight category slots if a player does not fit in to the range of weight slots specified (i.e. either being under weight or over weight), then in such case the player will be considered disqualified.
 - VI) In Kabaddi at the time of weighing Ten players should qualify the weight category, otherwise team will not be allowed to participate.
1. **In a calendar year, a player shall participate in a discipline through one age group and not through other age group in same discipline, subject to eligibility of class and age criteria. But has also the Option of Participating in other discipline in the same calendar year, through only one age group subject to eligibility of class and age criteria.**
 2. In the case of local migration for class 10th and 12th, a student can join the new school up to 31st May. Whereas XI class students migrating from other states should get admission before 31st July (Except for XI class students getting admission through Administration Centralized Process) for the current year. Any player getting admission after 31st May except class XI will get permission from

Director School Education, Chandigarh Administration to be eligible to participate in Inter School State Tournament 2022-23.

3. If a student participating in Inter School competition is found having enrolled in any other institution, the school team will be scratched immediately. To stop such incidents, the admission of the players/students shall be made on the production of original school leaving certificate and character certificate. The involved officials shall also be liable for departmental action against him/her.
4. Unrecognized schools are not eligible to participate in the State/National School Games. **The recognized schools having deposited sports affiliation fees of Rs. 5000/- to the Education Department shall only be allowed to participate in State/National School Games 2022-23 along with Undertaking by the school Principal regarding sparing services of their Physical Education teachers and their school playfields/courts/infrastructure for the conduct of Inter School Tournament, supervising camp and accompanying the contingent in r/o National School Games.**
5. There will be no competition if there are less than **Four Teams** in r/o Team games/**Four Players** in r/o Individual Discipline from different schools.
6. **In individual events, positions will only be declared when the competitors from four different schools will complete their bouts/tie/event.**
7. **One player** from a school will be allowed to participate in each weight category in r/o Weight lifting, Wrestling, Judo, Boxing, Taekwondo.. However, in the discipline of Swimming and Athletics two players from a school will be allowed to participate in each event. The **Event and Weight category** must be mentioned in front of each participant in the entry Performa. Addition/Deletion of participant/team can be done one day before the date of draws of fixtures with the written permission of Principal.
8. For D.O.B., the admission withdrawal register and original certificates will be considered to settle an objection raised by opponent team. The under objection team will produce the relevant record within 2 hours to the O/o District Education Officer. The objections/malpractices raised by any team will be dealt as per The Handbook of Instructions for Inter School tournament published by Education Department
9. The school must submit entry forms along with latest individual photograph of the players and must produced school I-Cards at the time of competition duly signed by the Head of the institution.
10. The District Education Officer may change the date/venue of the tournament due to weather conditions, clashing of dates with NSG or any other administrative reason.
11. The convener of the games shall ensure the availability of **FIRST AID KIT/DRINKINGWATERFACILITIES/MEDICALFACILITIES/DISCIPLINE/PROPER MARKING OF THE GROUND** etc. at the match venue. The Marble Powder will be provided by the DEO Office.
12. The officials put on duty for Officiating/Table Duty during the Inter School tournament are required to wear proper kit.
