

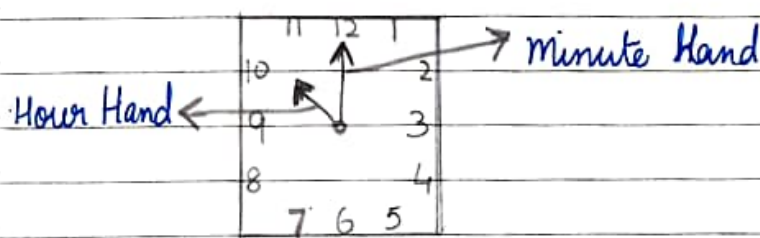

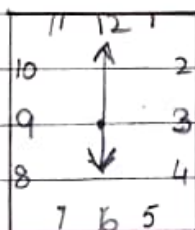
There are 24 hours in a day and 60 minutes in each hour. The hour hand moves twice around the face of the clock in one day. The clock move its hands is called clockwise.
