Remember :-

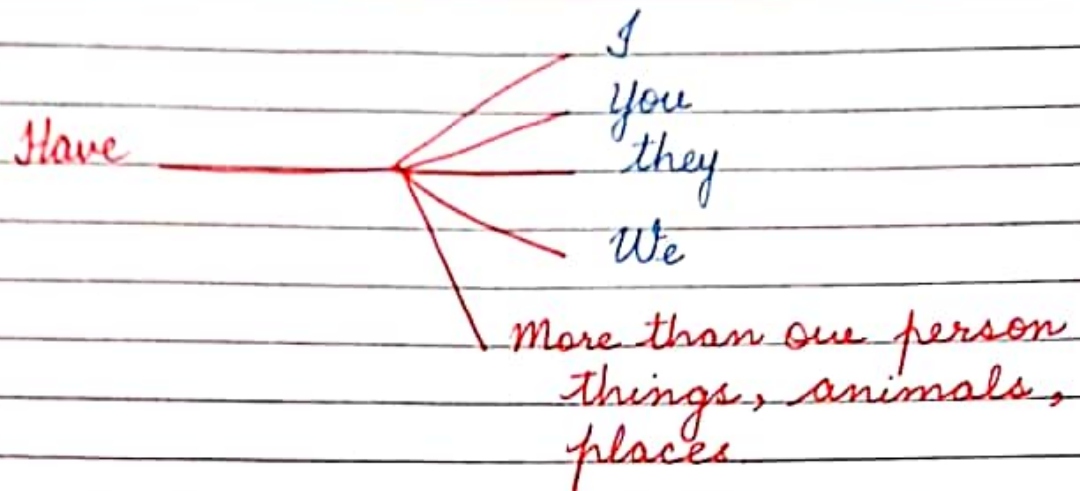
1. When you use I, you, we, they, you have to say have.
2. When you use he, she, it, you have to say has.

'Has' is used with a single person, animal or thing.

'Have' is used with more than one person, animal or thing.
