At Page No. 43 of your book 'My Grammar Time', we will read and learn about He, She, It.

He, She, It are called pronouns.
Pronouns are the words that can be used in place of nouns.

Pronouns (He, She, it)

Rule

1.

We use she for feminine gender
for example :- girl, mother, sister.

This is Rita. She is a girl.

We used She in place of Rita.

Rule

2.

We use he for masculine gender
for example :- boy, father, brother.

This is Raj. He is my friend.

We used He in place of Raj.

Rule3

We use it for a non-living thing and an animal.
e.g. table, bird, cat

This is my cat. It is white in colour

We used it in place of cat.
