used with I.

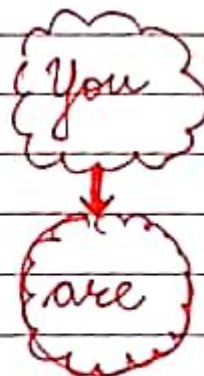
'You'
