Describing Words

Words that tell us more about naming words are describing words. Describing words are also called Adjectives. For example

a blue umbrella

a short pencil

a small ball

a tall tree

six books

two buses

Now all these words blue, short, small, tall, six, two are describing the nouns.

These describing words are generally used along with naming words.

- e.g. 1. I have a short stick.
2. My dress is blue.

The words short and blue are describing about stick and dress.

So Describing words say something about other objects, things or persons.
