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Topic :- Lesson - 11, Doing Words.

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Children you have already read in Class I that Doing Words are action words or verbs which tell us what a person, animal or thing does.

Now look at the pictures below and read the sentences -

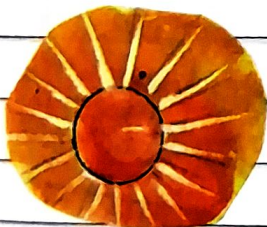


1. Birds live in the nest.

So children the words live, sits, shines, dance and runs are called doing words. These words tell us what the noun is doing. We can also call them 'Verbs' or 'Action words'.

So we can say - 'A word or group of words that expresses an action such as eat, sit, play, read, run, etc.'

Children, we either use the verb as it is or add 's' or 'es' to it in the present tense.

Please note how the form of the verb changes -

★ If the noun is in the singular form, the verb will be in the plural form. For example.

1. He runs very fast.
2. Rohan lives in a town.
3. She sings very well.

★ If the noun is in the plural form, the verb will be in the singular form. For example.

1. They run very fast.
2. Rahul and Rohan live in a town.
3. You sing very well.
4. I drink eight glasses of water everyday.

So children I hope you have understood the concept of verb and how to use it. Let us take up an exercise.

For example -

come - coming

give - giving

make - making

★ In some words, the last word is doubled to add 'ing'.

For example -

swim - swimming

run - running

sit - sitting

knit - knitting

stop - stopping
