

2. We bought apples and pears.




3. I have a racquet and a ball.

Here 'but' is used to join two sentences.


But children 'But' joins the sentences that have opposite ideas or different ideas.

1. Lata ran fast but missed the bus.




2. This jug is empty but that is full.




