

The means or vehicles that we use to travel from one place to another are called means of transport.

When we have to travel within the city, we use slow means of transport.



Some fast moving vehicles in a city are shown below:



When we have to move from one city to another, we use the following vehicles.



When we have to travel from one country to another, we use ship or an aeroplane.



The invention of wheel has made life very comfortable. We can move around faster and travel longer distances than ever before. Similarly, we can also move or transport things quickly. Movement of humans, animals and goods from one place to another is called transportation.

Some vehicles are run by humans, like cycle and rickshaw. Some vehicles are driven by animals like camel cart, bullock cart and horse cart.



Other vehicles need fuel to run from one place to another. Some of such vehicles are car, scooter, truck, train and aeroplane.

Fuel is a material that supplies heat and power to the vehicle. Some of the fuels used in vehicles are coal, petrol, diesel and CNG.



Did You Know?

CNG is a non-polluting fuel that is preferred nowadays.

Some other vehicles run on electricity. Example : Metro train and electric ferries.

Nowadays, battery operated cars and auto-rickshaws are very common as they do not pollute our environment. Petrol and diesel are not ecofriendly fuels. On burning, they release smoke that

pollutes the environment. Thus, we should try to limit the use of these polluting fuels and try to use more of non-polluting fuels like CNG.

Try to use bicycle or walk to go to nearby places.

Vehicles are causing noise pollution as well. Remember not to honk the horn unnecessarily.
