



Cricket

A cricket team has 11 players. Cricket is played on a specially-prepared strip of land, called the pitch, between the two sets of wickets.

Each wicket has three wooden stumps and two bails that are placed on the stumps.

A cricket test match lasts five days. One Day International (ODI) matches last only a day, and each side is allowed to play a maximum of 50 overs.

One team bats and the other fields. The fielder behind the wicket is called the wicket keeper.

Twenty-20 is the latest version of cricket in which each team is allowed to play a maximum of 20 overs.

An over has six deliveries.
