The words that tell us the position of someone or something with respect to others or each other or we can also say these words (prepositions) show the relationship of a noun or a pronoun with other word or words in a sentence.


Now let us learn the use of in, on, under, behind, near.


- * 'In' is used when an object or something is completely inside something.
- * 'On' is used when an object or something is touching the surface of something.
- * 'Over' is used when crossing from one side to the other usually when going up and then down.
- * 'Beside' is used when something is next to or at the side of
- * 'Between' is the space located in the middle of two people or things.
- * 'Above' is used when something is higher than


another object.

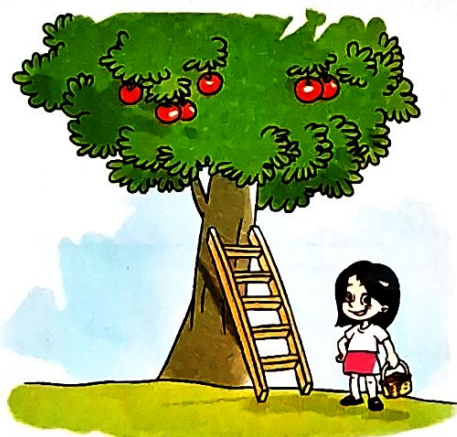

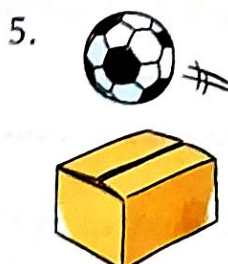
