Kutcha Houses

Kutcha houses are weak houses made up of mud, straw, bamboo and wood. These are commonly seen in villages. These houses need frequent repairs. Hut is a common kutcha house.

These are pucca houses. Pucca houses are strong houses made up of cement, bricks, iron, wood, tiles, glass, etc. Pucca houses are mostly found in cities.



Because of shortage of space, multi-storeyed buildings are built in cities. These are called flats.

Some Other Houses

Houses are built differently according to some factors. These are:

- 1. Availability of building material.
- 2. The climate of a place.
- 3. The budget available to build a house.
- 4. Need of the family.

Different houses are built in different areas. Some houses that are used for a short time are called temporary houses. Here are a few examples:



A tent is made up of canvas. It is used for camping. NCC cadets and scouts use tents for camping.

A caravan is a house on wheels. It is used by people who keep moving from one place to another.





An igloo is a house made of snow. It is made in very cold places. People who live in igloos are called Eskimos.

A houseboat is a house on a boat. It is a floating house. It is found in lakes of Kashmir and Kerala. These houses are a great attraction among tourists.

Houses on hills have sloping roofs. These are made so that the snow slides down easily. Houses in plains have flat roofs.





People living in areas with heavy rainfall make houses on stilts. Such houses are called stilt houses.

A plumber fixes water pipes.
