

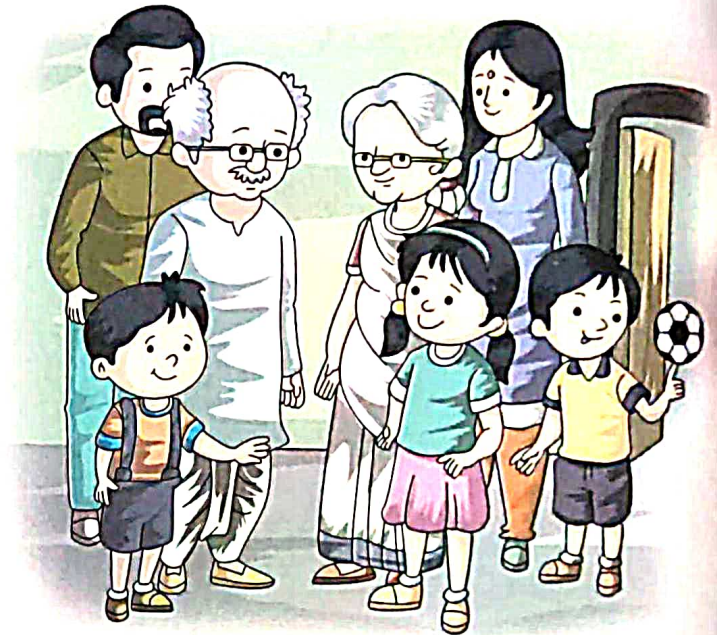


Others in My Family

A family lives together in a house. Parents and children together make up a family. Here are different types of families:

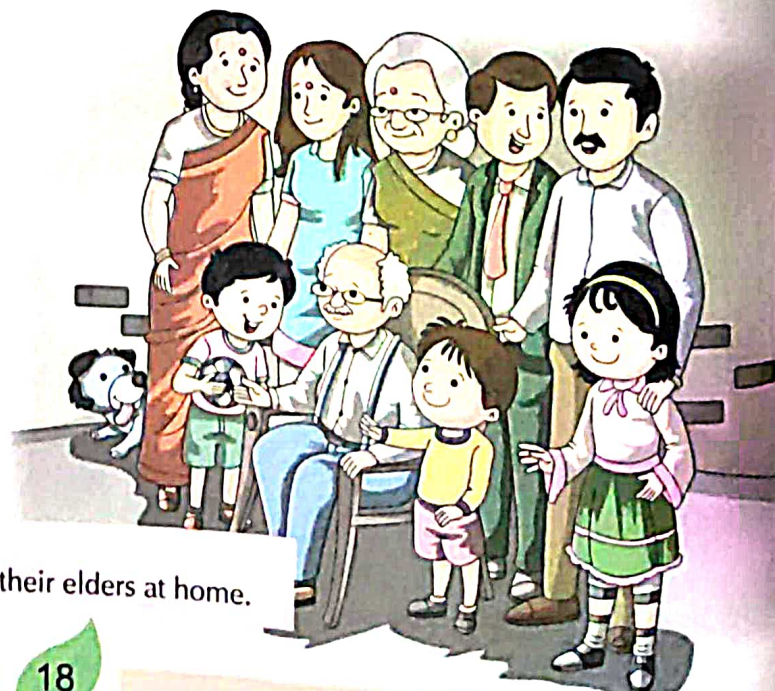


Small family
(A family having one or two children.)



Big family
(A family having more than two children.)

Joint family
(A family where parents, grandparents, uncles, aunts and children live together.)



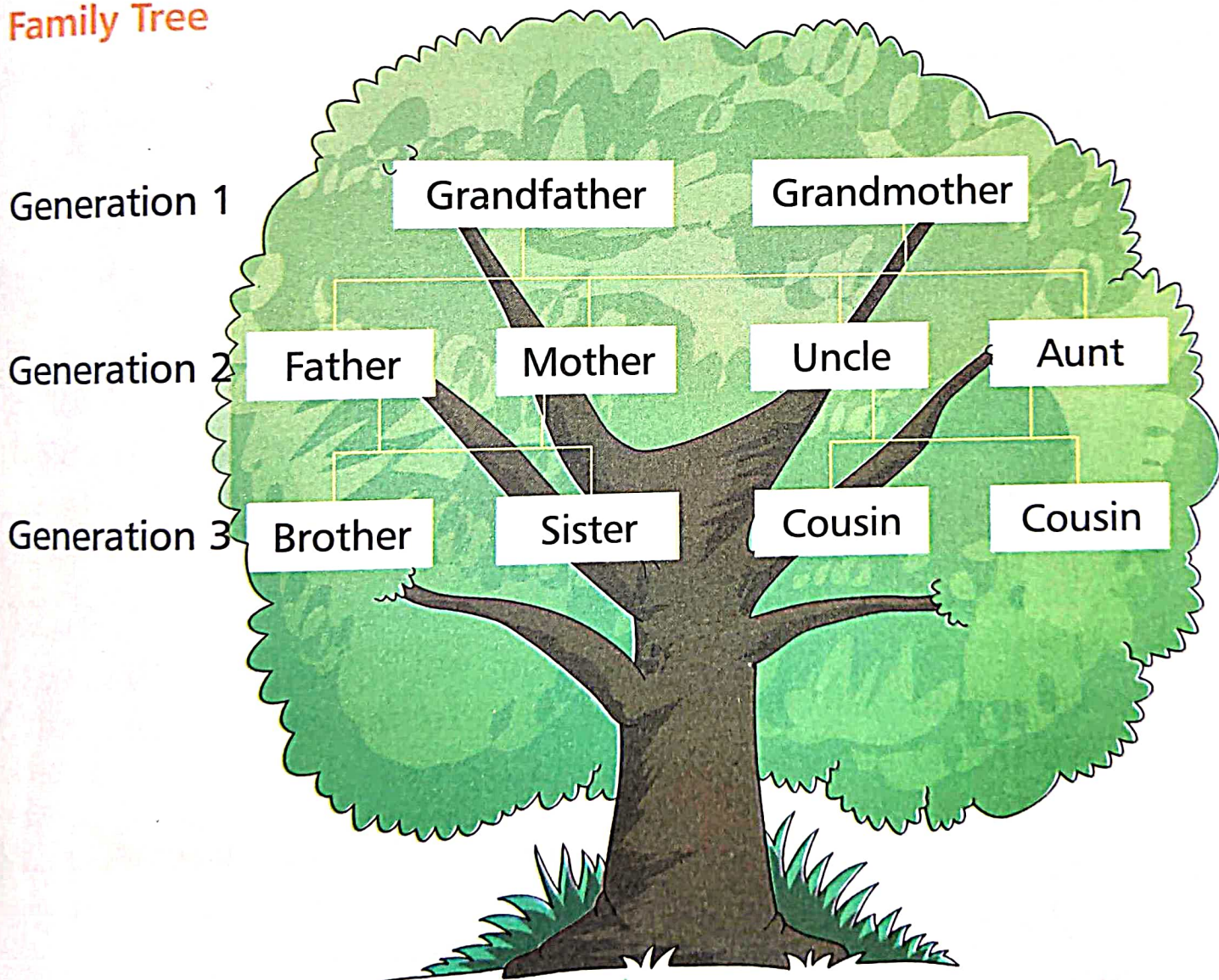
Teacher's Tip

Care and Concern for Others

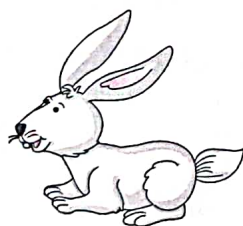
The animals that we keep at home are called **pet animals**. Some of the animals kept as pets are dog, cat, rabbit, fish and parrot.



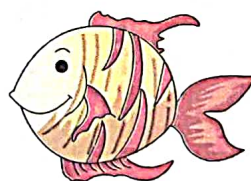
Dog

Parrot

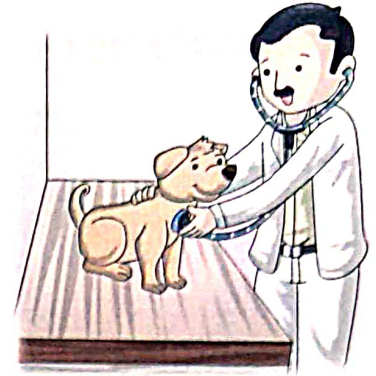
Pets live in our home as extended family members. We play with our pets. We should take care of them.

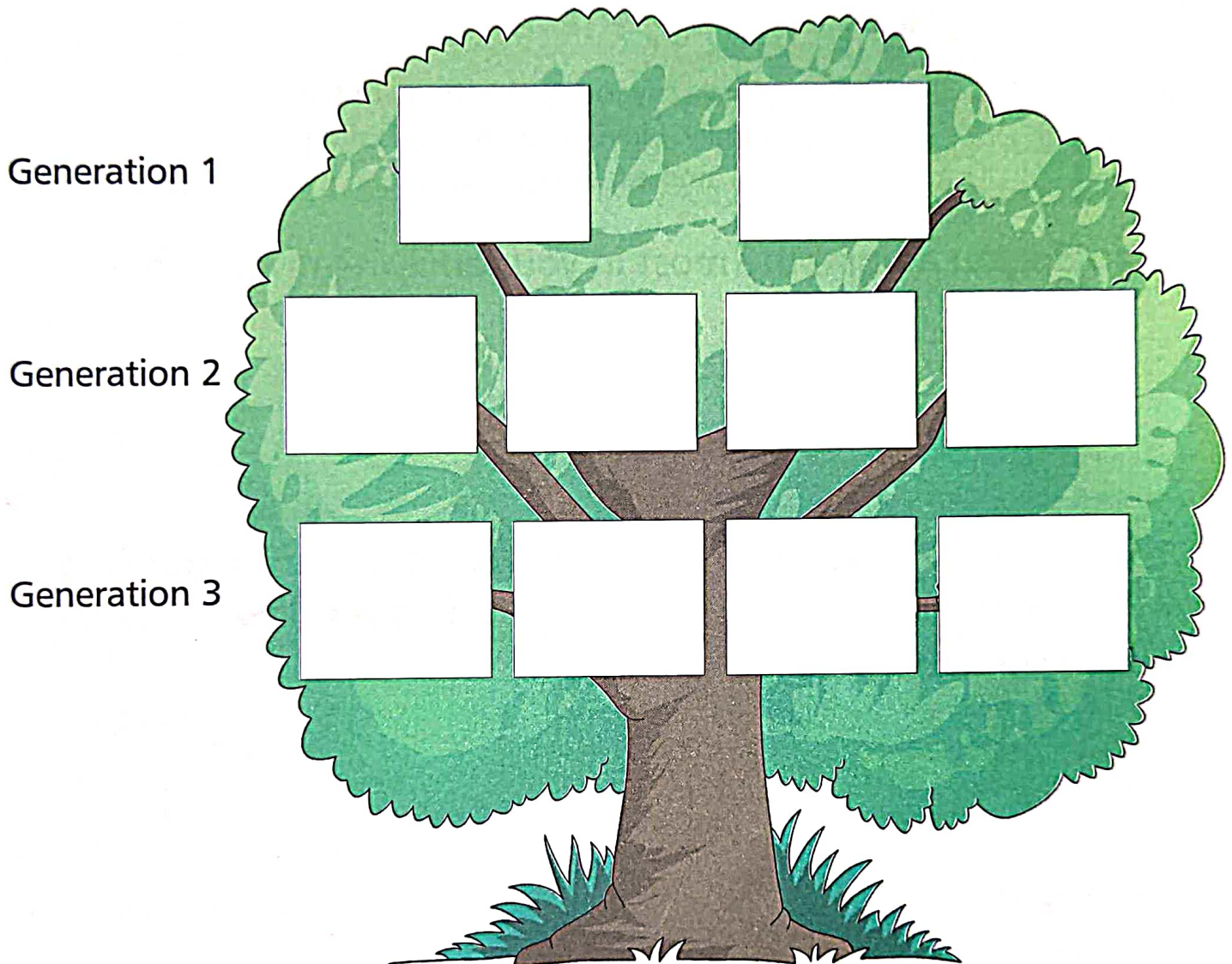
