They are also called adjectives Describing words tell us more about size (tall, big); shape (round, square); colour (green, red); number (one, hundred); quality (beautiful, heavy, old) For example sharp knife Beautiful girl Green saree One balloon Sweet grapes Brown dog. The words Sharp, Beautiful, Green, One Sweet and Brown are describing words. * Describing words describing persons, places, animals and things. For example tall boy, big city, fat hen, yellow mug * Adjectives usually come before the noun they describe for example -1. Mukul is a good boy. 2. Mumbai is a big city. * Sometimes adjectives come after the noun they describe and may be separated by a verb For example -1 These apples are juicy. 2 This icecream is tasty.
