Q What is an adjective?

Ans. A word that tells something about a noun is called an adjective. It is also called a describing word.

For example:

a. Rita is a pretty girl.

b. It is a hot day.



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The word **pretty** describes a girl or Rita. The word **hot** describes a day. So, the words **pretty** and **hot** are describing words or **adjectives**. They tell us more about persons, places, animals or things.

- Adjectives tell us about the **colours** of nouns.

- Adjectives tell us about the **sizes** and **shapes** of nouns.

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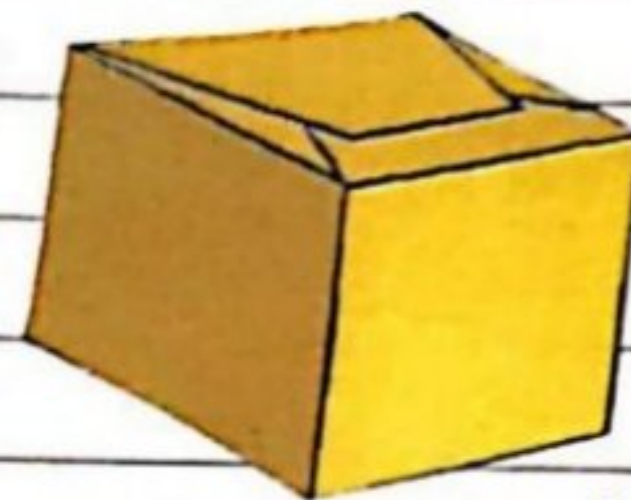

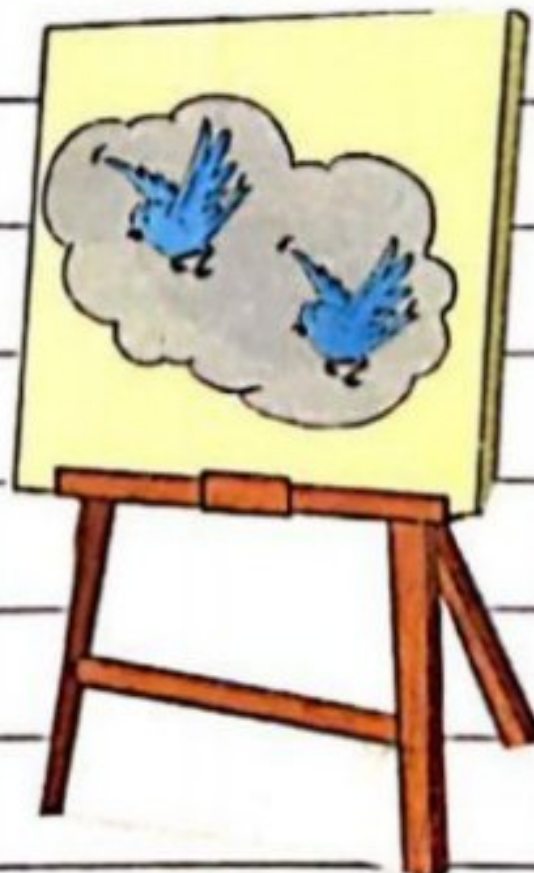
- Adjectives tell us about some special qualities of nouns

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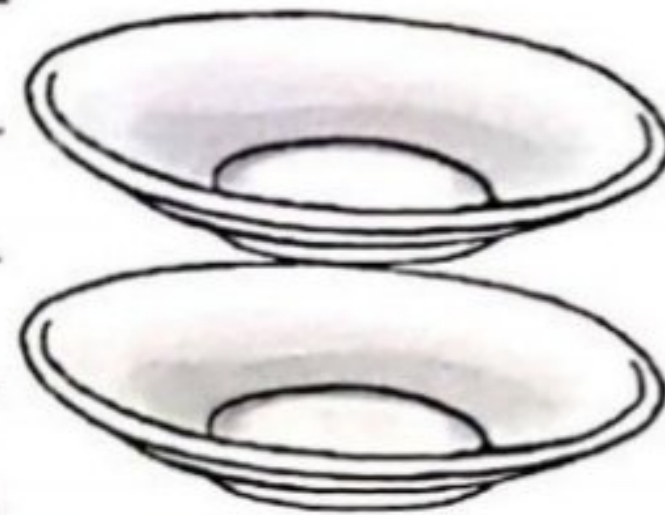
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- Adjectives tell us about the numbers of nouns.

ALWAYS REMEMBER!

To find the adjective in a sentence, first find out the noun or the pronoun. Then, look for the words which describe that person or thing. These words are adjectives.

For example:

My grandfather has a big, black typewriter.
