Units of Money

We have seen money in the form of notes and coins. In India, the money (currency) used is called Rupee and Paise.

₹ 3.50
rupees $\leftarrow$ $\rightarrow$ paise

A. Write the following in figures

1. Twenty five rupees = ₹ 25
2. Seventeen rupees twenty five paise = ₹ 17.25
3. Fifty rupees = ₹ 50
4. Thirty rupees fifty paise = ₹ 30.50
5. 1 Thousand rupees = ₹ 1000
6. 89 rupees = ₹ 89
7. 65 rupees 75 paise = ₹ 65.75
8. 500 rupees = ₹ 500

C. Convert the following to paise

1. ₹ 9

$$₹ 1 = 100p$$

$$₹ 9 = 9 \times 100p \\ = 900p$$

2. ₹ 7.05

$$₹ 1 = 100p$$

$$₹ 7.05 = 7 \times 100p + 5p \\ = 700p + 5p \\ = 705p$$

3. ₹ 9.95

$$₹ 1 = 100p$$

$$₹ 9.95 = 9 \times 100p + 95p \\ = 900p + 95p \\ = 995p$$

4. Ten rupees

$$₹ 1 = 100p$$

$$₹ 10 = 10 \times 100p \\ = 1000p$$

5. Seven rupees sixty paise

$$₹ 1 = 100p$$

$$₹ 7.60 = 7 \times 100p + 60p \\ = 700p + 60p \\ = 760p$$

6. 12 rupees 5 paise

$$₹ 1 = 100p$$

$$₹ 12.05 = 12 \times 100p + 5p \\ = 1200p + 5p \\ = 1205p$$
