Q1. Why do all living beings need water?

Ans All living beings need water to live.

Q2. What part of the earth's surface is covered with water?

Ans About three-fourths of the earth's surface is covered with water.

Q3. Name the gaseous form of water.

Ans Steam is the gaseous form of water.

Q4. List some properties of water.

Ans Some properties of water are

- i) Water has no colour, smell or taste.
- ii) Water is a good solvent.
- iii) Water occupies a definite amount of space.

Q5 What is the difference between solute and solvent?

Solute	Solvent
The solid substance which dissolves in a solvent is called solute. Examples salt and sugar.	The liquid part of a solution in which a solid substance dissolves is called solvent. Example water.

Q6 List the conditions that affect making a solution.

Ans Conditions affecting making of a solution are :-

- i) Stirring the solution
- ii) Temperature
- iii) Size of solute particles

Q7 What are soluble and insoluble substances? Give some examples.

Ans i) Soluble substances - Substances which mix well with water are called soluble substances. e.g. salt and sugar.

ii) Insoluble substances - Substances which do not mix well with water are called insoluble substances. e.g. oil and paints.
