I'm a student
of Class 4.

You're my

She's my sister.
He's my brother.

They **can't**
listen to me.



Let's know the full forms of the contractions used in the above words.

I'm → I am

You're → You are

She's → She is

Can't → Can not

He's → He is

Contractions are the words that have been made shorter by leaving out letters while writing, we place an apostrophe (') in place of the missing letter(s).

Examples : 1. I + am - I'm

2. He + is - He's

3. They + are - They're

(one letter has been replaced with an apostrophe)

4. They + will - They'll

5. They + have - They've

6. I + will - I'll

(Two letters have been replaced with an apostrophe)

Some examples of contractions are given below.

I am → I'm
she is → she's
he is → he's
it is → it's
we are → we're
they are → they're
is not → isn't
are not → aren't
do not → don't
does not → doesn't
did not → didn't
have not → haven't
had not → hadn't
will not → won't
should not → shouldn't
would not → wouldn't
cannot → can't
could not → couldn't


Short forms, or contractions, are formed by shortening two words and putting them together.
