Good Morning Students,

Students, this lesson is of class 3 for the subject of computess, Topic - 'Drawing Different Shapes' which is covered in chapter-5.

- All the students, May Now Please open page no-56 in front of them.
- I hope all the students are ready for today's lesson, So let us start with topic - 'Draw Different Shapes'.

* children, you have already worked in MS-Paint in previous class also. All of you know that MS-Paint provides so many different tools, colours etc. with the help of these colours and tools, you can create any type of drawing and make it beautiful. In this Chapter 'Fun with Paint' - you are going to learn about more new tools and features of Paint. Different tools are as follows:-

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1. Line tool :- ^{It is} Used to draw straight lines of varying thickness using different colours.
2. Rectangle tool :- Used to draw rectangular or square shapes.
3. Oval tool :- With this tool, you can draw ovals or circles.
4. Polygon tool :- This tool helps to draw polygons with any number of sides. Star shapes like this , you will be able to draw with this tool only.
5. Fill with colour tool :- This tool will fill colour in different shapes.
6. Pencil tool :- This tool is used to draw free-form lines or curves. Like you use pencil for making drawings in your notebooks.
7. Eraser tool :- This tool is used to erase or remove any part of your drawing that is not required.
8. Airbrush tool :- This tool is used to spray any colour in the picture.
9. Select tool :- With the help of this tool, you can select any part of the picture.

Students, Now, we are going to study the next topic present on page No- 56 in your book and the topic is - Page-2

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Drawing Different shapes:- Students, In paint while making drawings, you can ^{use} different shapes that are present in 'Shapes Group'. These are ready-made shapes as shown in figure- in your book. We are going to follow some steps for 'inserting' shapes in the working or drawing area of MS-Paint. Steps are:-

1. Click on any ready-made shape.
2. Drag the mouse on the paint window with left mouse button.
3. Now click on outline and change the style.
4. Click on size and change the line thickness.
5. Click on color 1 for outline colour and colour 2 for fill colour to change according to you.
6. Now, you will see the picture with the colour that you have applied to it.

Students, All of you, May now take three minutes break. During break time, you will draw any shape ^{or drawing} with your imagination in your notebook. After drawing the shape, you will fill colour inside or outside means outline of the shape; with different colours of your choice. After completing this activity, Please show this to your parents.

continue with the next topic present in your book on page no. - 57 and the topic is - 'Callout shape'.

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students, while reading comic books or cartoon books, you see different shapes in which dialogues are written for different cartoon characters. These ^{type of} shapes are known as callout shapes.

In MS-Paint also, you will get different types of callout shapes for typing text. Paint provides three types of callout shapes - These are:-

- ① Rounded Rectangle callout ② Oval callout ③ Cloud Callout

For these callout shapes, follow figure present in your book

Now, we will follow some steps to insert ^{or draw} callout shapes.

1. Select any callout shape from shapes group.
2. Drag the mouse pointer on the drawing area and draw the shape.
3. Select fill with colour tool and click inside the callout shape to fill colour in the shape.

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4. Select the text tool and click inside the shape. One text box will appear with a cursor. Now type the text.
