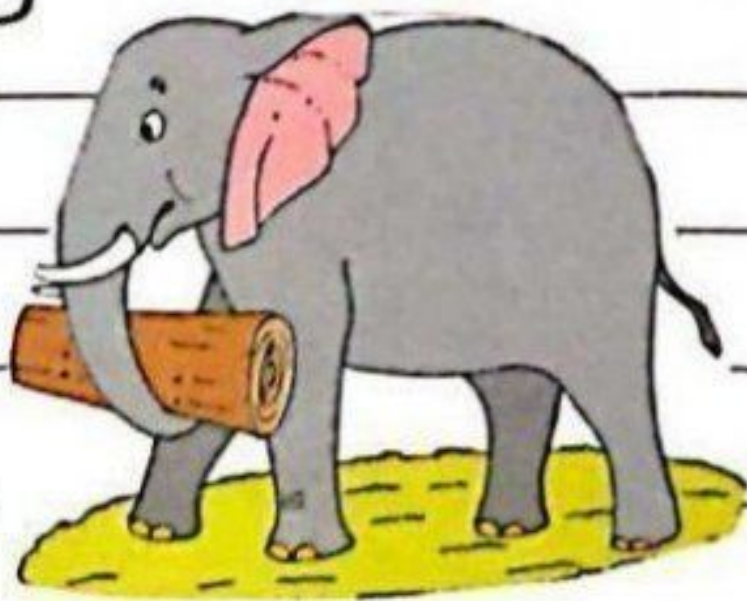

★ When a proper or common noun ends with 's', it shows that something belongs to them.

★ Apostrophe with -s ('s) is used to show that something belongs to someone.

Read these sentences.

1. Nilesh is Rahul's brother.

Here, 'Rahul's brother' shows that Rahul and Nilesh are related.



2. Rohini's school is in Noida.

Here, 'Rohini's school' means the school in which Rohini studies.

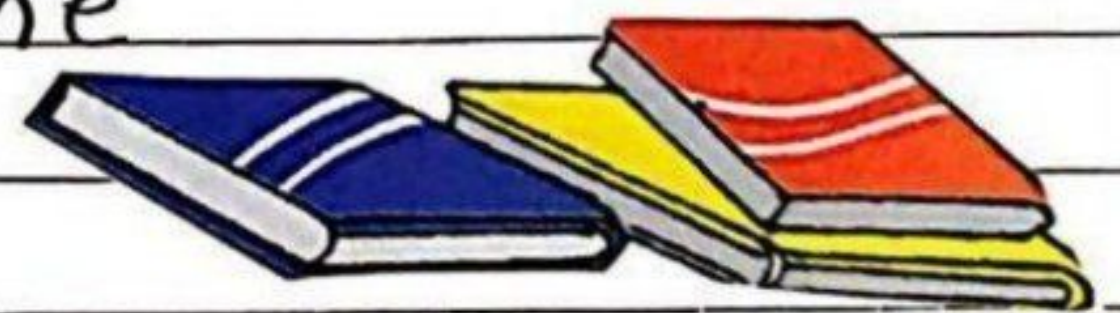
★ Apostrophe('s) is also used to show that something is related to another.

★ When the noun is in the singular, the apostrophe (') comes before -s.

Read these sentences.

i. the tails of the dogs
- the dog(s') tails

ii. the books belonging to the students
- the student(s') books



★ When nouns talk about more than one thing, they usually end in 's'. In such cases, we only add (') to show belonging.
