Students, this lesson is of class 3 for the subject of computers, Topic- 'flipping the picture' which is covered in chapter-5 starting on page no.-60 of your text book, titled - 'Kips logix-3' and is being submitted to you on 25.11.24.

- All the students may now please open page no.-60 in front of them.
- I hope all the students are ready for today's lesson. Let us start with topic - 'Flipping the picture'
- \* Children, Flipping the picture means to rotate the selected picture horizontally like row format or vertically like column format. For flipping, we are going to study the following steps:-
  1. Select the picture with Selection tool.
  2. Click on Home tab and choose Rotate option.
  3. A list will appear with rotation or flipping options.

Follow figure- 5.9 for flipping and rotation present in your book on page no- 60.

4. Select the desired option.
5. The effect will be applied on the selected picture.

\* Students, Next topic, you are going to study is present on page no- 60 in your book and the topic is:-

\* Resizing / Skewing the picture :- Students, this means, you can change the size of the picture - horizontally or vertically. You can increase or decrease the size of the picture. You will use percentage or pixels for making any type of change in picture size in paint. For this, we are going to follow some steps and the steps are:-

1. Select the drawing with selection tool.
2. click on Home tab and select the Resize option.
3. Students, after this one dialog box will appear - as shown in figure - in the book present on page no- 61. Please follow this figure - for using Resize and skew.
4. Here, specify the size in 'percentage' or 'pixels' - and skew the picture by changing in degrees for both horizontal and vertical.
5. You can fill any number in these boxes, according to your requirement. click on OK.

1. Draw any picture - Here, In your book, you will see one picture of smiling face present in figure - on page no. - 61
  2. Zoom in and zoom out options are present on view tab.
  3. Zoom in will increase the view size of the picture.
  4. Zoom out will decrease the view size of the picture.
  5. You can also use Magnifier tool in place of zoom in or zoom out option from Home tab.
  6. When you will use Magnifier tool then '+' will increase the view size and '-' will decrease the view size of the selected picture.
- \* Children, Now, I am ending the lesson here,  
All of you will read this lesson carefully and try to understand the concepts of Flipping, Resizing, Zooming - the picture.
