These words make sense now. When words are placed in a proper order, they form a sentence.

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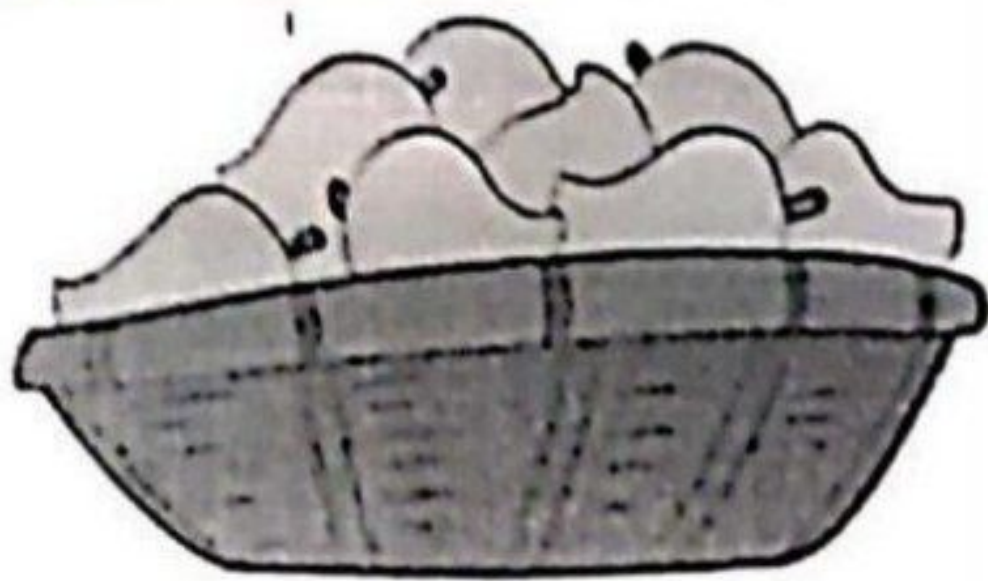
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A sentence always has a verb (action word) and a subject. The subject of a sentence is a person, place or thing that does or is something. A sentence begins with a capital letter and ends with a full stop, question mark or exclamation mark.
For example:



The basket is full of mangoes.



The bunny is eating a carrot.



Lily is drinking tea.

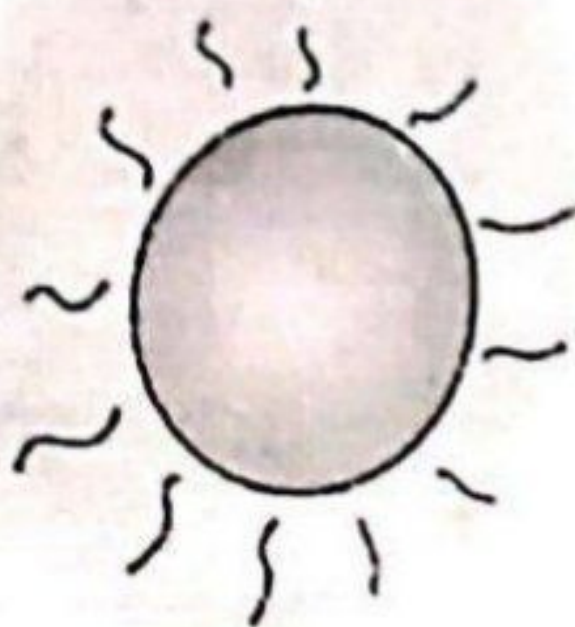
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The sun shines in the daytime.



Annie gets up at 6 o'clock



Jack is having a lollipop.

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In the first sentence, we speak about the
basket.

In the second sentence, we speak about
the bunny.

In the third sentence, we speak about
Lily.

In the fourth sentence, we speak about
the sun.

In the fifth sentence, we speak about
Annie.

In the sixth sentence, we speak about
Jack.

★ In a sentence, the person, animal, thing or place that is being spoken about is called subject.
