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Types of Families:- A family can be of two types:-

1) Small or nuclear family

2) Big or joint family

Small or nuclear family:-



Nuclear family

A small family is also called a nuclear family. It consists of parents and one or two children. All the family members look after each other and share joys and comforts together.

Big or a joint family:-

It is a family in which many members like parents, children, uncle, aunt, cousins and grandparents live together, as you can see in the given picture.

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Single parent family:-

Some families consist of just one parent and the child or children. Such a family is called a single parent family.

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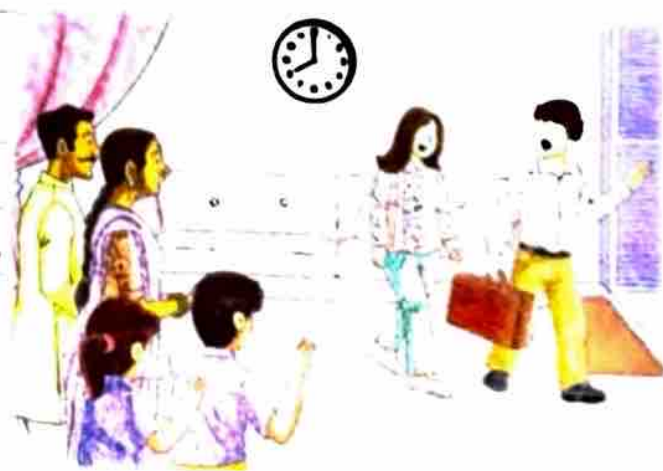
Good Morning Students,

1) Working Parents :-

Nowadays, there are some families where both the parents go out to work while grandparents take care of the children and the housework during

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the day. The parents help when they are back from work. Sometimes in nuclear families, both the parents go to work and the househelp looks after the children. The children may also stay at a day-care school or in a creche, while their parents are at work. Some parents keep care-givers to look after the children.

2. A Homemaker :-

In some families, only one parent goes out to work. The other stays back at home to take care of the children and the household work. Such a parent is known as the homemaker of that family.

The size of a family may change due to many reasons. The size of the family refers to the number of family members. Let us look at some situations that bring these changes.

1. The Birth of a child or sibling :-

The word sibling means a brother or a sister.

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Sometimes, there is an addition of a new member in the family. Sometimes, a baby girl or boy is born. The family becomes bigger in size with the coming of a new member.

2. Marriage in a Family :- A marriage is a happy time for the family. All family members gather and have a lot of fun for a few days. Every family has a special way of celebrating weddings. Marriage adds or removes a member in the family.
