COMMUNITY HELPERS :- First of all we will discuss what is community.

* community :-

People who live together in the same neighbourhood form a community.

They take up different occupations and give us various services.

* Occupation :-

Any work that is done by a person to earn money is called occupation.

* Community Helpers :- People who help us in our day-to-day work are called community helpers. Such as teachers, doctors, postmen, plumbers, policemen, farmers etc. In our

society community helpers play a major role. ⁽²⁾
We should be polite and friendly to our community helpers. We must show respect to them. Let us know more about the community helpers.

1) Soldiers :- A person who serves in an army is called a soldier. They protect us from our enemies. They sacrifice their life to keep the people of the country safe and secure. We all should be proud of our soldiers.



2) Farmers :- The role of farmers in our society is very important. They work in fields to grow crops like fruits, vegetables, grains, pulses, cereals etc for us. We need food to survive. The life of a farmer is very tough, as they work hard day and night in all seasons.



3) A Teacher :- The person who gives us education is a teacher.

We learn reading, writing, singing, dancing, painting and even physical exercises with the help of a teacher. Teachers help us to develop good habits. We celebrate 5th September as Teacher's Day every year to show our love and respect to our teachers.



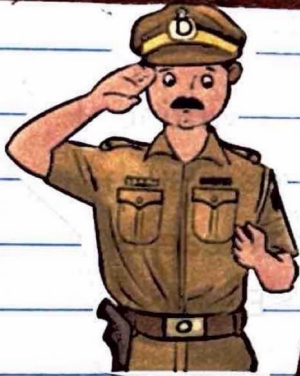
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4) A Doctor :- The person who treats sick people is called a doctor.

The doctor looks after our health and gives us medicine whenever we are sick. We must never take medicines without consulting a doctor.



5) A Police Officer :-



The people who protect our life and property are called policemen or policewomen. A police officer maintains law and order in an area. The police may arrest anyone who breaks the law. We can call police by dialling 100 whenever there is a need.

6) A Firefighter :- A firefighter is a person who puts out fires.

Firemen work at fire stations.

If there is a fire in our house, we call the fire brigade.

The fire brigade puts out the fire. To call the fire brigade, we have to dial 101.

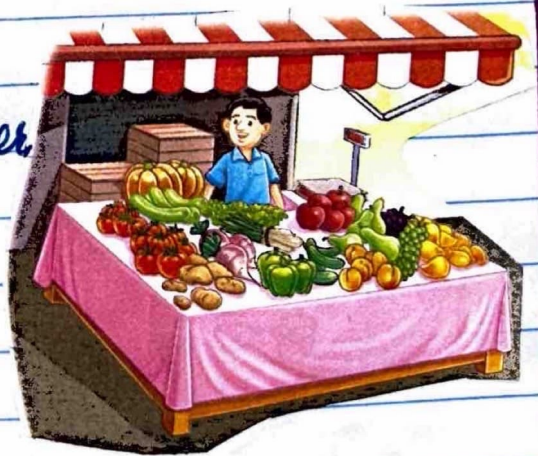

8) A Carpenter :-



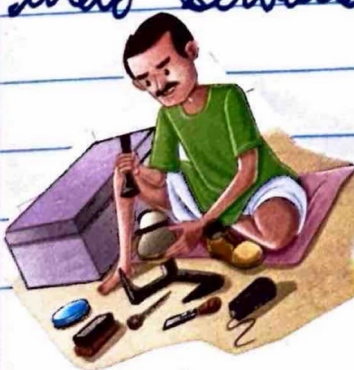
A carpenter makes furniture for us as well as wooden items like doors and windows for our homes and buildings.

They also live in our neighbourhood, for example Cobbler stitches and repairs our shoes, The Cleaner sweeps and cleans our streets, The Plumber repairs our taps, and the Mechanic repairs cars and bikes.
