Children, you already know that a noun that gives a general name to people, animals, places or things is called a **common noun**. For example, postman, cow, park and ruler are common nouns.

Common nouns can be either living or non-living. Living things can be male or female. Examples: lion, boy, bull, man, uncle (male)
lioness, girl, cow, woman, aunt (female)

Masculine gender nouns are used for male living things. **Feminine gender** nouns are used for female living things.

Here is a list of some **masculine** and **feminine gender nouns**.

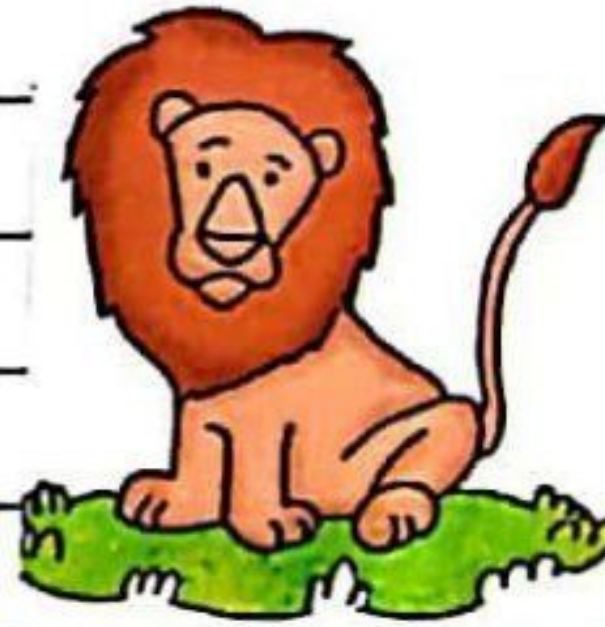

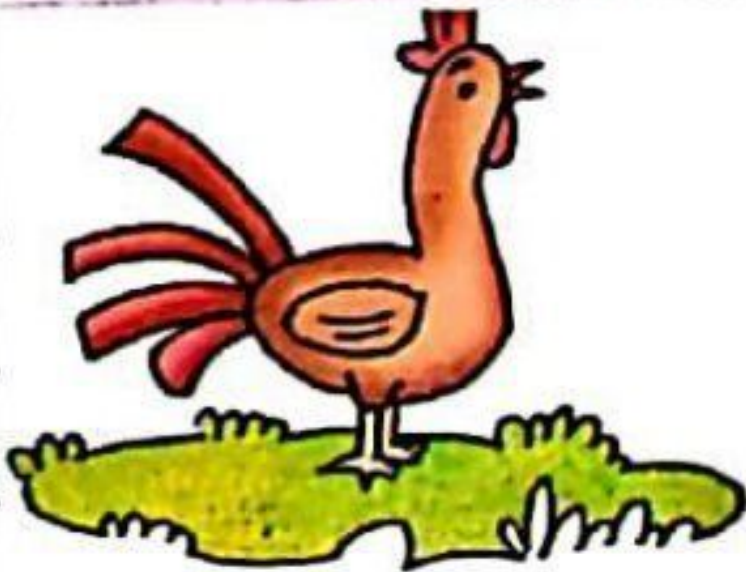

ALWAYS REMEMBER!

Generally, we refer to animals as it. However, if they are kept as pets, we can use he for male pets and she for female pets.

Non-living things do not belong to masculine or feminine gender. They are called **neuter gender nouns**.

Examples: car



bucket

box



Some nouns are used for both masculine as well as feminine genders. They are called **common gender nouns**.

Examples: 1. Rajesh is a **singer**.

2. Anshika is a good **teacher**.

In the above examples, the nouns **singer** and **teacher** can either be male or female. Here are list of common gender nouns.
