WATER TRANSPORT :- The vehicles that are used to travel on water are known as means of water transport. All forms of water transport float on water. These are very helpful in places which are surrounded by water. There are many kinds of water transport. For example ships, boats, ferries, yachts, rafts, rowing boat and paddle boats etc. Some move with the help of wind, while some require human effort, like rowing and paddling and some other have engines that help them move. We can travel long distances on ships. This is the cheapest means of transport.

Harbours are the areas of sea near coast which are protected from the open sea by strong walls, where ships can shelter. Ships can sail only in deep water, thus seas have large harbours.
