

Topic - "Telling Time"

Good Morning students,

This lesson is of class-III for the subject of S. studies in which chapter-5 "Telling Time" is continued with the explanation of the topic - "Measuring Time" and "Timeline". Students we have already discussed the topic - "Time" in the previous week. This week we will be discussing the topic Measuring Time and Time line. So all the students may please keep their 'Social studies' notebook ready as we are going to start our today's topic.

Measuring Time :- We measure time in hours, minutes and seconds. The long hand on the clock face shows us the minutes and is called the minute hand. The short hand on the clock face shows us the hours and is called the hour hand. 60 seconds make one minute and 60 minutes make one hour. There are 24 hours in a day.

60 Seconds = 1 minute

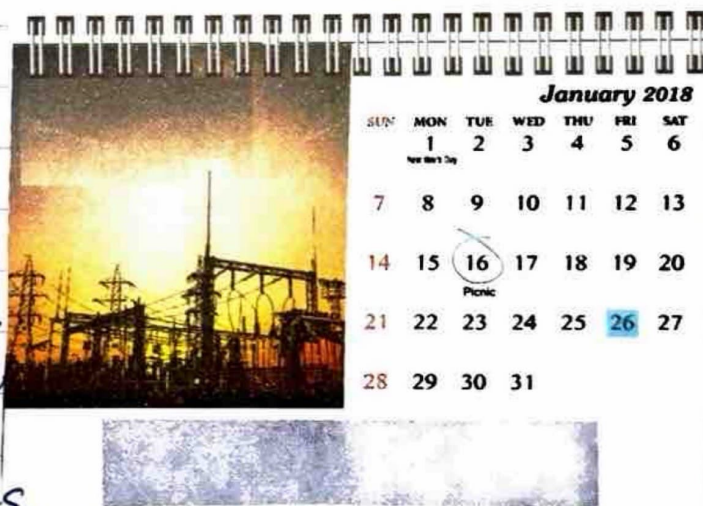
60 Minutes = 1 hour

24 hours = 1 day

365 days = 1 year

Let us discuss about the Calendars

A calendar is a set of pages that show days, weeks and months of a year. A calendar help us to remember important events such as birthdays, festivals, new year's day etc.

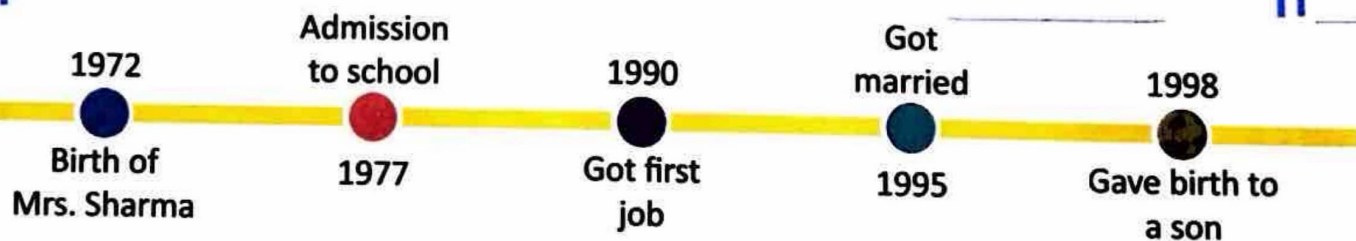


A month has 30 to 31 days. One the second month, which is February has 28 or 29 days. There are 12 months in an year. There are 365 days in a year. A leap year, which occur once every four years, has 366 days. A calendar shows us the months, weeks and days in a year.

TIMELINE :- A timeline is an arrangement of events in the manner in which they happened, starting from the first to the last. It helps us to remember and memorise important events. A timeline helps to know the date of events and also to know the time between two or more events. We can make a timeline for a day, week, month or year.

Now we will learn how to draw a timeline. Look at the timeline of Mrs. Sharma given below:-

- 1972 - Mrs. Sharma was born
- 1977 - She started going to school
- 1990 - She got her first job
- 1995 - She got married
- 1998 - She gave birth to a son



This timeline shows the important events that occurred in Mrs. Sharma's life in a time span of 26 years.
