Children we have already done Pronouns
in the previous chapter. In ^{this} chapter,
we will discuss 'Reflexive Pronouns'.

Look at these sentences.

1. I did my work **myself**.
2. You have to go there **yourself**.
3. We booked the air tickets **ourselves**.
4. She baked the cake **herself**.

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The highlighted pronouns are called reflexive pronouns. The pronouns help us to give more importance to the subject (to whom we are talking about in the sentence) in the sentence.

Definition

Reflexive pronouns are words that refer back to the person, animal or thing. The words myself, yourself, himself, herself, itself, ourselves, yourselves and themselves are reflexive pronouns.

For example:

1. Kate fell and hurt herself.
2. We can do the project ourselves.

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Look at the table to help you remember reflexive pronoun to use with pronouns.

Singular Pronoun	Reflexive Pronoun
I, me	myself
You	yourself
He, him	himself
She, her	herself
It	itself

Plural Pronoun	Reflexive Pronoun
We, us	ourselves
You	yourselves
They, them	themselves
