TOPIC: Chapter 9, Adjectives of Quality

Asha and Nisha are talking about a painting.

Oh, what a pretty painting! You can see the bright sun, the mountains and the hillocks.



There are white clouds, and three birds are flying in the sky. There is also a big river flowing through green trees. A beautiful sight indeed!

The highlighted words in the above conversation

appear before nouns and they tell us something about those nouns. Such words are called **adjectives**.

Adjectives are describing words that provides more information about nouns or pronouns. They describe persons, animals, birds, place or things. **Adjectives** are also called **describing words**.

For example :

1. The dog's fur is **soft**.



In the above sentence, the word '**soft**' tells us about the skin of the dog when we **touch**.

2. This is a **weekly** magazine.



The word '**weekly**' tells us how often that magazine is printed or reached which is called **frequency**.

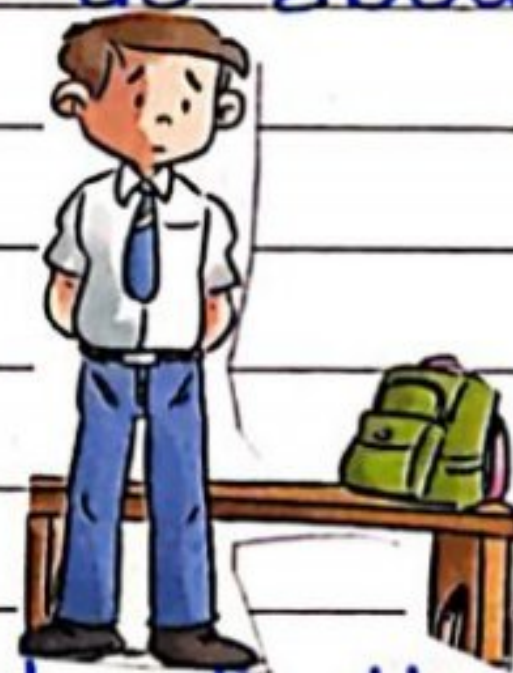
3. Peacocks are blue and peahens are brown.



The words 'blue' and 'brown' tell us the colour.

4. There is red book on the square table.

The word 'square' tells us about the shape of the table.



5. I have a new bag.

The word 'new' tells us about the age of the bag.

6. An angry lion roared in the forest.

The word 'angry' tells us about feelings of the lion.



7. The brave soldiers fought for our country.

The word 'brave' tells us about the quality of the soldier.



8. A **little** squirrel lives on the tree.

The word '**little**' tells us about the size of the squirrel.

Children, the words such as **soft, weekly, blue, brown, red, square, new, angry, brave** and **little** are adjectives.

Adjectives of Quality describe the kind or quality of a person or thing.

They also include words which describe:

- ★ **shape** : circular, square, oval, flat
- ★ **size** : huge, large, tiny, small, little
- ★ **colour** : blue, green, golden, red
- ★ **touch** : hard, soft
- ★ **feelings** : happy, sad, angry
- ★ **quality** : kind, honest, beautiful
- ★ **age** : old, new
- ★ **frequency (how often)** : weekly, yearly

Dear Parents,

At this level of English Language of Class IV we will teach the children '**Adjectives of**

Quality in the form of describing words and its kind. You may collect few items from your house and show it to the child for better understanding such as **soft pillow, colourful box, four pencils, yellow banana** so that the child understands the concept of adjectives easily.

Kindly take the break for five minutes to do the above activity.

Children you must have had fun. Now let me check whether you have understood the concept of adjectives.
