1. Name the boundaries of the Peninsular Plateau.

Ans. The Peninsular Plateau has Eastern Ghats in the east, Western Ghats in the west and northern plains in north.

4. Name three tourist attractions of the state of Tamil Nadu.

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E. Answer these questions in detail

Ans. 1: Madhya Pradesh is a large state located in central India. Bhopal is its capital city. River Narmada, Tapi, Chambal, Son and Betwa flow through this state. Farmers cultivate cotton and wheat in this region.

Ans. 2: Few mineral rich states of India are Chhattisgarh, Karnataka, Odisha, Jharkhand, Andhra Pradesh and Telangana. Mining is the major occupation of the people living in these states. These states are rich in both metallic and non-metallic minerals. For example Iron ore, manganese, coal, etc.
