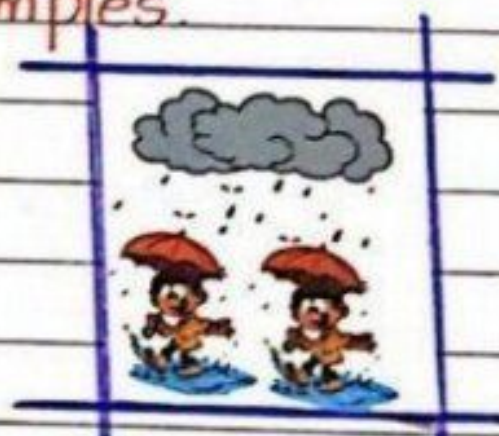

Children, Capitalization of certain letters and using punctuation marks at suitable places in a sentence is very important. They make our writing more readable and attractive.

Look at the following examples.



Niki is crying.



The boys are dancing in the rain.



Tim is going with her mother.



Nisha loves her puppies and kittens.

TOPIC Chapter 30, Punctuation

TEACHERS NAME Pamel preet

★ A sentence begins with a capital letter and ends with a fullstop (.)

★ Names of person, place and all proper nouns are written with a capital letter.

★ For example: Niki, Tim and Nisha are proper nouns that are written in capital letter.

Use of capital letters

★ for the first word of a sentence

For example: 1. There are beautiful plants in the park.

2. People visit the park to see these plants.

★ for the personal pronoun I

For example: 1. James called me when I was studying.

★ for proper nouns

For example:

Raman	India	Lucknow	Taj Mahal
Ganga	Himalayas	Ria	France
G.T. Road	South Pole	Australia	South Block

★ for the days of the week, months of the year and special occasions.

For example:

1. I will meet you on Monday, 20th May.

2. We must participate in the Republic Day Parade.

★ for the names of subjects

★ for the names of languages
English French Tamil

★ for the names of books, newspapers and magazines.

Full Stop (.)

We use a full stop

★ to mark the end of a sentence.

For example: 1. I reached school on time.

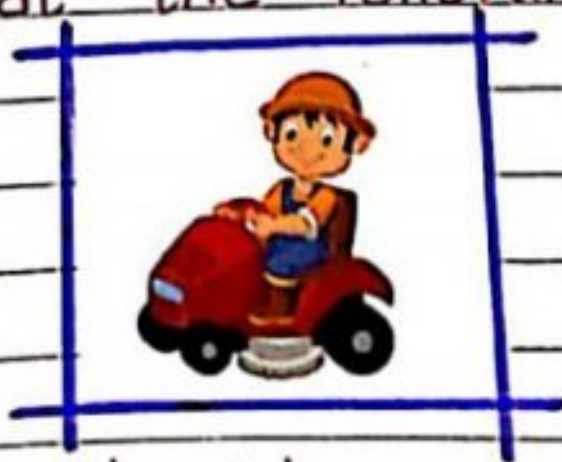
★ after the initials of a person's name.

For example: 1. Dr C.V. Raman was a great scientist.

Children, I hope you have understood the usage of capital letters and full stop.

Now, we will start with question mark.

Look at the following examples.



Can Amit ride a scooter?



How many letters are there in english alphabets?

Do you know how to paint?



★ A question mark (?) is used at the end of a question.

For examples. 1. What is your name?

2. Where do you stay?

3. When is your birthday?
