im (prefix) + possible (root word) = impossible (new word)

in (prefix) + active (root word) = inactive (new word)

★ A **prefix** is a letter or group of letters added to the **beginning** of a word to form a new word with a different meaning.

★ A **suffix** is a letter or group of letters added to the **end** of a word to form a new word.

★ A **root word** is a word that can stand alone when a **prefix** or **suffix** is removed.
For example:

↪ help + ful ↩ = helpful ↩
(root word) (suffix) (new word)

↪ use + less ↩ = useless ↩
(root word) (suffix) (new word)

★ We can form the opposites of some words by adding a group of letters to them.

★ Suffix **-ful** means **full of**

★ Suffix **-less** means **without**

★ Suffixes come after the **root word**.
