Some is used with uncountable and plural countable nouns in positive sentences and questions.

Examples : uncountable nouns (water, butter, time); plural countable nouns (books, marbles)

Use of 'Any'

1. She does not have any friends.
2. Did you buy any toys?
3. He has not answered any question.

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4. There aren't any vegetables in the basket.

5. Is there any chocolate in this ice cream?

Any is used with uncountable nouns and singular or plural countable nouns in a negative sentence or a question.

Examples: uncountable nouns (work, chocolate); plural countable nouns (vegetables, toys, friends)

★ Negative sentences are sentences that have no or not in them.

Much is used with uncountable nouns.
