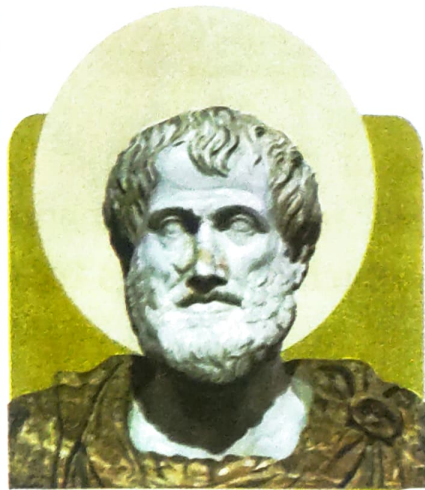
4. Vladimir Lenin was the founder of modern Communist Russia. He liberated the country from the Czars and become Head of its first communist government.

6. Adolf Hitler was the dictator of Germany during World War II.



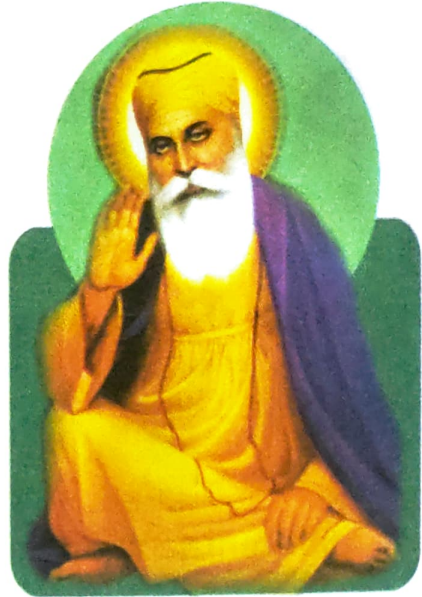
