Garbage:

The waste material which we generate everyday is known as garbage.

Types of Garbage

★ Degradable Waste:

The waste substances that can not almost completely forming simple substances. are known as degradable waste. eg: Kitchen waste

★ Non-Degradable Waste:-

These substances are those which do not rot completely when buried under the soil for a long span of time.

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Reducing non-degradable garbage in the surrounding:-

1.) Used as landfill:

Non degradable waste are filled in landfills and it is covered with soil. Later, it is used as a park or a playground.

2.) Avoid using plastic bags:

Plastic is difficult to dispose off. We should use cloth or jute bags.

3.) Recycling:-

Some articles can be sent for recycling.

4.) Reducing the use of disposable material.

We should ^{not} use non-degradable items as these accumulate in our surroundings.

5.) Reusing:- Plastic and glassware can be reused to reduce garbage in surroundings.

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6.) **Don't throw carelessly:**

Plastic bags should not be thrown carelessly as these block the drains and may lead to flood like situation. When there is heavy rainfall.

7) **By using separate bins:-**

Blue bin is for materials that can be used again.

Green bins are used for collecting degradable waste.
