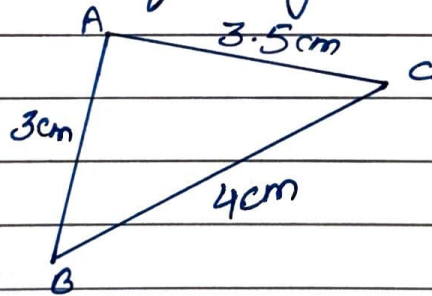

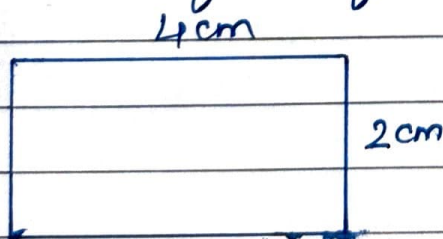

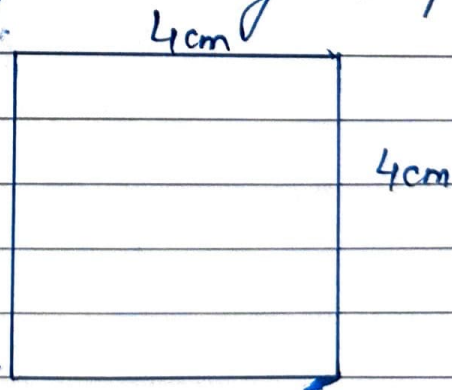
- Q1. A triangle has sides 6 cm, 8 cm, and 10 cm. What is the perimeter of the triangle?

- Q5. Which of the following figures has greater perimeter?

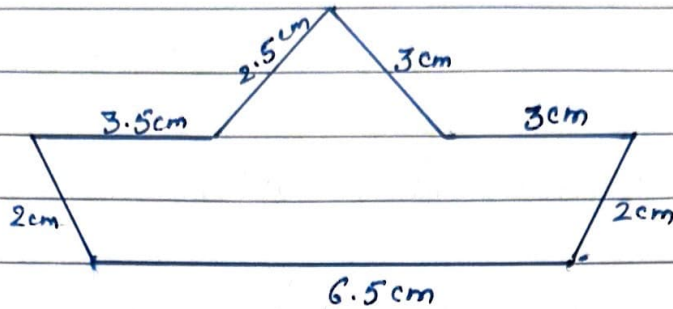

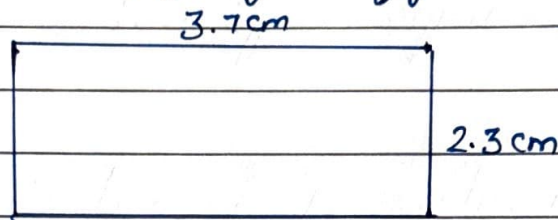

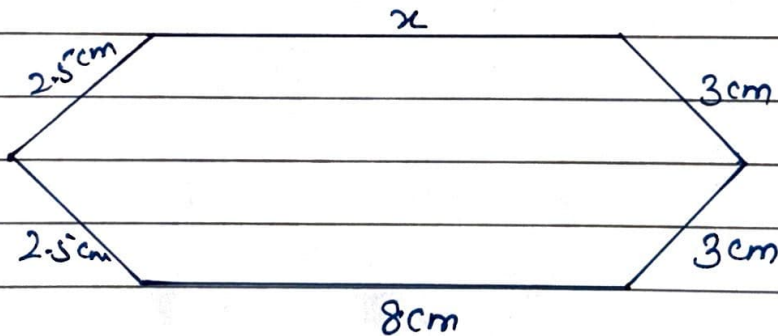
