Good Morning Students,

Today in the subject of English Language we will discuss Articles.

Children! The words 'a', 'an' and 'the' are called articles. They are demonstrative adjectives and are used to point out people or things.

- \* A and an are indefinite articles.
- \* The is the definite article.
- \* A and an suggest any person or thing.
- \* The suggests a particular person or thing.

#### \* Use of Indefinite Articles

Students, we use indefinite articles 'a' and 'an' before countables in the singular number. For example

a boy  
an egg

a tree  
an ox

a shop  
an umbrella

#### \* Use of 'A'

The use of a and an depends upon the sound of the countable noun before which it is used (placed).

We use a before a countable noun (that can be counted like boy, tree) in the singular number beginning with a consonant.

sound. For example

a man

a flower

a cow

Children, in words having consonant sound,  
we use a.

For example

a University, a European

a one rupee note

\* Use of 'An'

Children, we use 'an' before a countable  
noun in the singular number beginning  
with a vowel sound.

For example

an ant, an apple, an axe

The words ant, apple and axe begin  
with a vowel sound, so 'an' is used  
before these words.

Some words where 'h' is silent, they  
begin with a vowel sound and take  
'an' before them.

For example -

an hour

an honest

\* Use of 'the':

'The' is used before a particular person  
or a thing. for example -

Close the window on your right.

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\* With Superlatives.

For example

This is the best show I have ever seen.

\* With words like first, last, next, only:

For example

Who is sitting on the first seat?

\* With a common noun when that noun represents the whole class. For example

The rose is a beautiful flower.

\* With earth, moon, sky, sun etc.

For example

The earth revolves round the sun.

\* With the names of rivers, seas and oceans:

For example

The Narmada falls into the Arabian Sea.

\* With the names of mountain ranges:

The Himalayas lies to the north of India.

\* With the names of holy books:

The Ramayana, The Bible

\* With the names of trains, ships, aeroplanes etc For example

The Shatabdi Express, The Rajdhani Express

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- \* With the names of countries if the name includes a common noun:

The U.K. and the U.S.A are developed countries.

- \* With the names of newspapers.

The Times of India, The Tribune

- \* With the names of well known buildings:

We visited the Taj Mahal last week.

- \* Omission of the Article

[When no article is used] Students!

1. No article is used with proper nouns

For example

Ashoka was a kind ruler.

New Delhi is the Capital of India.

2. No article is used with abstract nouns.

Beauty pleases our heart and eyes.

Honesty is the best policy.

3. Children | no article is used with such nouns as gold, silver, water etc. for instance; Gold is an expensive metal.
