

Natural Vegetation

The natural vegetation of South America is influenced by different types of climate experienced in various parts of the continent.

- More than 40% of South America is under thick forest.
- 30% is under grasslands.

→ Types of Natural vegetation of South America



① Equatorial Rainforest:-

Equatorial Rainforest are also known as Tropical Rainforest, and they are found in the Amazon Basin and coastal plains of Guyana, Venezuela, Ecuador and Colombia.

- the Amazon rainforest are called Selvas (largest tropical forest in the world)
- Trees found: Mahogany, rubber, cinchona, rosewood, ebony.
- Selvas of the Amazon Basin are also called 'lungs of the world'

(2) Temperate Grassland:-

- They are also called the Pampas and found towards the south of Gran Chaco in N. Eastern and Central Argentina and Uruguay.
- this is an area well-suited for cattle grazing, dairy farming and wheat cultivation.

(3) Tropical Grassland:-

Vegetation consists of grasslands of the Savanna type, with tall and coarse grass.

- these grasslands are called 'Llanos' (Orinoco Basin) and 'Campos' (Brazilian Highlands)
- Tropical forests with deciduous trees are found here.

(4) Cool Temperate Forest:-

- They are found in southern Chile.
- this vegetation is a combination of deciduous and green evergreen trees.
 - eg:- Antarctic beech, Chilian pine and Giant Alerce.

⑤ Warm Temperate forests:

They are found in the Gran Chaco region of Argentina, Paraguay and Bolivia.

- the vegetation consists of deciduous forest, thorny scrub forest and swamps.

⑥ Mediterranean forest:-

→ These forest of central Chile has plant with waxy leaves and long roots that goes deep into the Earth, can survive the hot dry summers.

- the bark of plants is thick and spongy, so as to store water for the dry period.
- Types: oak, walnut, chestnut, cacti, shrubs and citrus fruits.

⑦ Desert vegetation:-

Desert vegetation is found in the rain shadow areas of Atacama and the Patagonia desert. Vegetation is very limited because of scanty rainfall.

- vegetation types:- cactus, prickly pear, scrubs, thorny bushes

⑧ Mountain Vegetation:-

These vegetation found over the Andes mountains.

- lower areas of these slopes have tropical forest. South region the slopes in the east have deciduous trees and higher altitude the vegetation changes to coniferous forests.

→ wildlife of South America

South American rainforest, swamps, grasslands, rivers and mountains have a wide variety of animal and bird species.

- more than 15,00 species of colourful birds and it is also known as the 'Bird Continent'
- Amazon forests are home to armadillos, tapirs, giant ant eaters, crocodiles, alligators, pumas, anaconda, monkey
- the Tropical forests have birds like toucans, egrets, hummingbirds, parrots and flamingos.
- the Pampas grasslands have ostrich, guanaco, & jaguar
- the llama are domestic animals used by the people of the Andes Mountains.
- the sand of the Atacama is home to rodents, geckos, iguanas, lizards and turtles.
