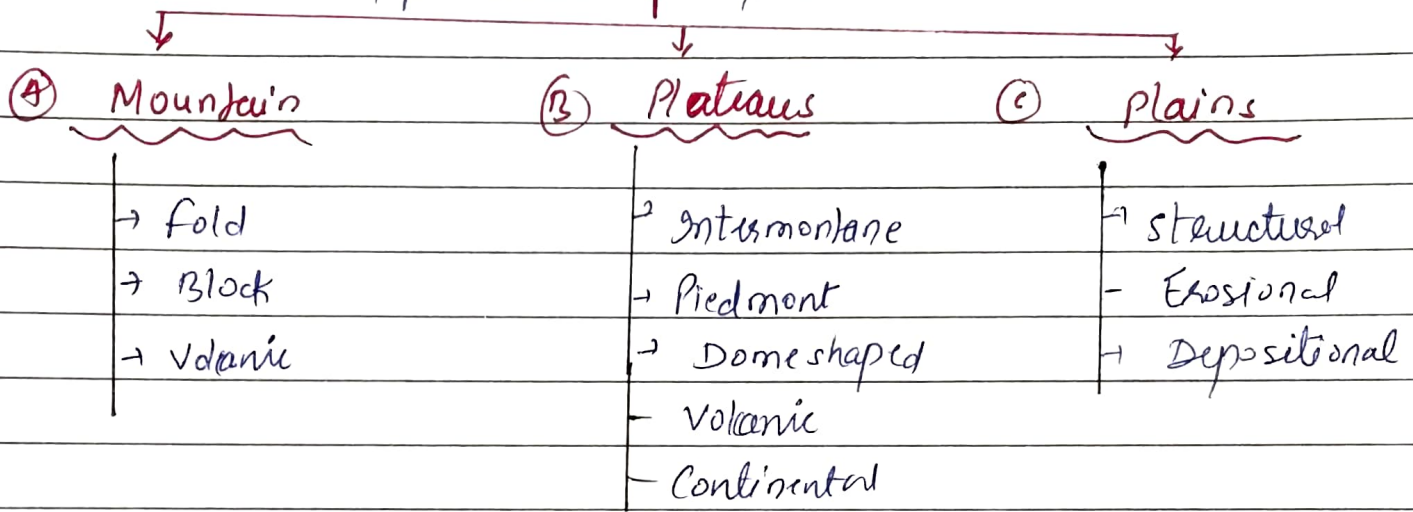

* Waterbodies: It includes oceans and other features that form the hydrosphere.

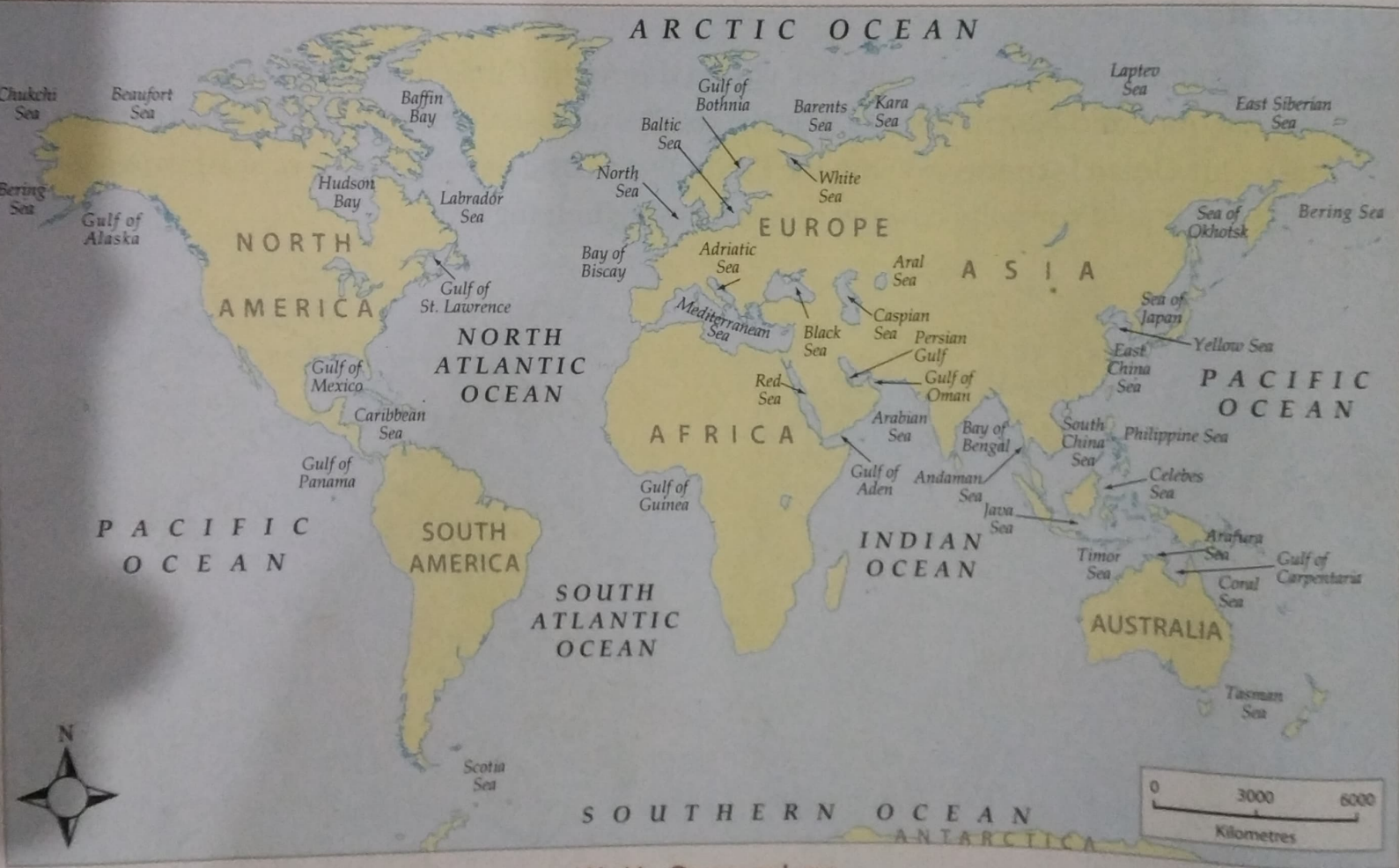
