Q) Give reason:

(a) Agriculture is the base of Indian Economy.

Ans. Agriculture is the base of Indian Economy because:

- It provides food and fodder crops.
- It helps to promote internal and international trade.
- It is the source of our national income.
- It provides raw materials for industries.

(b) Green Revolution has revolutionised the Indian Agriculture.

Ans. It revolutionised Indian Agriculture in following ways:-

- It led to increase in production of food grains in India.
- It made India self-sufficient in food grains.
- It decreased import of food grains in India.
- It helped to increase the share of agriculture in nation's National Income.

(c) Coffee is grown on hill slopes.

Ans. It is grown on hill slopes because:

- The climate on hill slopes is cooler ranging between 24°C to 28°C .
- To provide even water to the crops and avoid water logging.

(d) wheat is Staple food in Temperate areas

Ans This is because:
