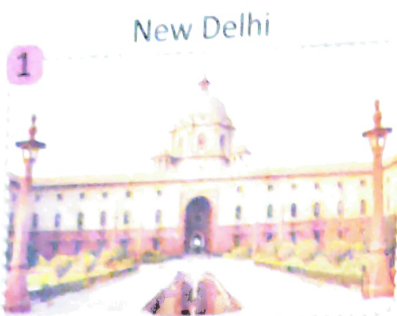

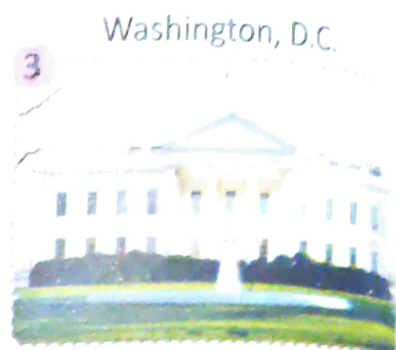
Residence of the President of India.

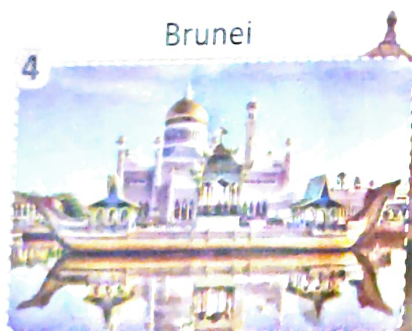

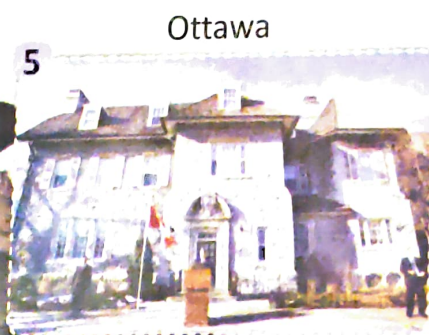

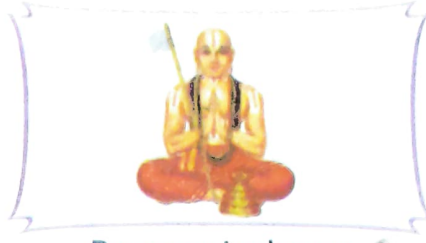

3. He was an Indian Hindu monk, philosopher, author, religious teacher, and the chief disciple of the Indian mystic Ramakrishna. He was a key figure in the introduction of Vedanta and Yoga to the Western world. Swami Vivekananda
4. He was an 8th century Indian Vedic scholar and teacher. He taught the reading of the Shastras and Advaita Vedanta teachings of his time. Adi Shankaracharya
5. He was a prince. He gave up his wealth, palace and family for the search of the truth. Gautam Buddha
6. He was the founder of Sikhism. His teaching says- "God is one, whether, He be Allah or Rama". Guru Nanak Dev
