INSERTING IMAGES

On webpage along with text, you can display charts, maps, graphics, drawings or images also. These elements make the web page more appealing. Images can also be used as navigational tools to help users browse through the Internet. The most used formats are GIF, PNG and JPG formats. Web browser support various ^{Other} graphic formats also such as BMP, SVG, PNG, ICO.

Image: An Image is a visual representation of something or you can say an image is a picture that has been created or copied and stored in electronic form. There are two types of images.

Inline image: The inline image is displayed when the web page is opened and inserted within a line of text that means inline images are images embedded in the text. The image will flow as if it were part of the text. Images supplied for Back Text Design and Formatting books should be supplied inline.

The `IMG` tag is used to insert images within text. Note that the `IMG` tag is not a block tag by itself, so it must be used only within a block element.

External Image: External images are not displayed automatically with other content on the web page. Instead, they are referenced externally and viewed separately by clicking on the link. To insert an external image, the anchor tag <A> is used, that establishes a link to the image.
