This week we will study about the crusades and the impact of the Monasteries.

In the eleventh century when the Turks captured Jerusalem, they threatened the Christian visitors. The Christians believed that their religion was under threat and they decided to go on a Holy War to recapture Jerusalem. Between 1096 CE and 1291 CE, eight Crusades were fought. However, the crusaders were unable to recapture Jerusalem.

The Crusades increased the Pope's authority among Christians. The crusaders were exposed to the cultural and scientific progress of the Greeks and Turks. This laid the foundation for a revival of interest in classical knowledge. It also paved the way for increased trade contacts between Europe and Asia.

The monasteries were also important in medieval Europe. They were centres of learning - both religious and secular. Monasteries helped in spreading Christianity. The monks also served the people who needed help. They grew herbs in monastery gardens and used it to treat the sick people.
