## Distribution of Population in India

- Rural population implies people living in villages.
- Urban population implies people living in towns and cities.
- India is the most populated country.
- In India 70% population resides in urban areas and 30% in rural areas.
- According to Census 2011, India has:
  - \* Total population - 121 crores
  - \* Density of population - 382 persons per  $\text{km}^2$
  - \* Sex ratio is 943 females per 1000 males.
  - \* Child sex ratio for females - 919 per 1000 males.
  - \* Level of Urbanisation is 31.17%.

## Sex Ratio

It is defined as number of females per 1000 males in a given population.

## Reasons for Unfavourable Sex Ratio in India

- Females are neglected and males get preferential treatment.
- New born females are killed.
- Many women die at time of delivery.
