The intellectuals of the beried inspired people to raise their voice against injustice and to fight for their nights The American War of Independence also inspired the people of Prance. The year 1789 was important in French history as King Louis XVI called the meeting of Estate general - a body having

The system was such that when a decision had to be taken it was one vote per Estate and not one man one vote. So the Third Estate demanded it. Its members met lat Tennis Court and took an oath to stay united till a new Constitution was dragted Louis XVI took steps to control the National Council But the common people attacked Bastille (where prisoners were (kept) and broke open its gates. The prilsoners were set free. As a result of which a new municipal government called Parks Commune' was formed. The suler was forced to accept people's demand.
