
Tides and Ocean Currents

(1) Introduction:

- Hydrosphere refers to the mass of water that occupies the greatest part of Earth's surface.
- It occupies 71% of the earth's surface.
- It includes oceans, rivers, ponds, lakes, glaciers etc.

(2) Distribution of Land and Water:

- Land occupies 29% and water occupies 71% of Earth's surface.
- Northern Hemisphere has more dominance of land whereas southern Hemisphere has more dominance of water.
