

Ch-11 Problem of Unemployment in India

Consequences of Unemployment:-

1. Wastage of Productive Resources:-

Unemployment leads to wastage of human resources. The idle manpower also means underutilisation of physical and financial resources. If unemployment is among educated persons, then the quantity of wastage of resources will be greater. This is because of too much investment is made in education.

2- Low level of Output:-

Unemployed people could not make any contribution to country's production. Therefore, the level of output in the economy remains at low level.

3. Increase in Poverty:-

Unemployment is a source of poverty. Unemployed people are generally poor. Hence, unemployment adds to the number of persons who are below the poverty line. During the period of mass unemployment, the extent of poverty and inequalities of income tend to increase.

4. Increase in Economic Burden:-

Unemployment tends to increase economic burden. The dependence of the unemployed on the working class increases, thus, the overall quality of life is adversely affected.

Suitable Employment Measures and Policies

Various employment measures have been divided into two categories

(i) Long Run Measures (ii) Short Run Measures.

Long Run Measures:-

The following measures are suggested to solve the problem of unemployment in India:-

1. Accelerating growth rate of GDP.
2. Reform of Educational System
3. Emphasis on the use of labour intensive techniques of production
4. Creation of self-employment opportunities.

- (4) Skill Development.
- (5) Entrepreneurial Development.
