Today we will do Map Work- On Physical Map of World we will locate Mountains and Plateaus of the world.

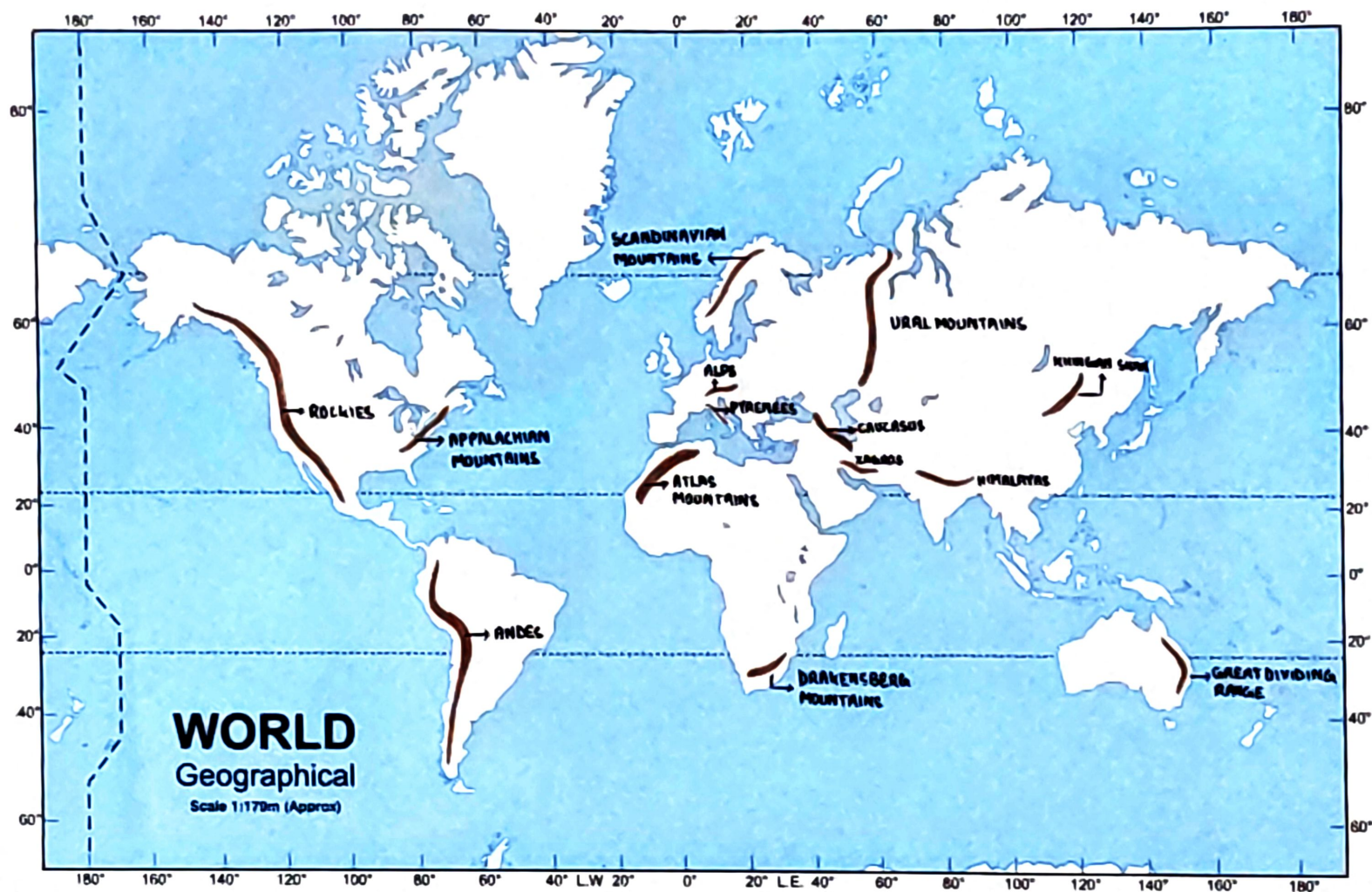

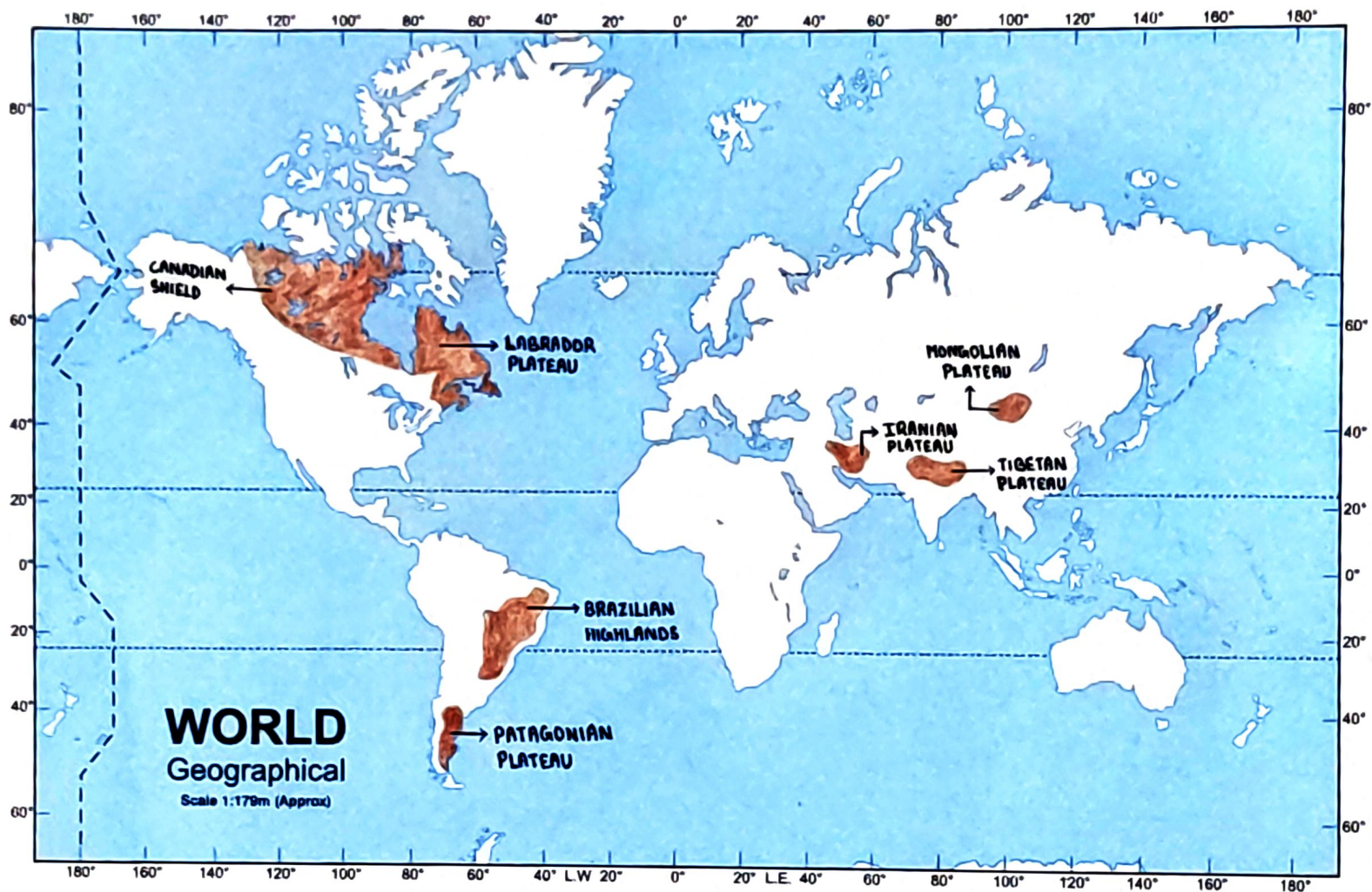
